- The General Manager hired was unable to make the move to Bellingham due to personal family reasons. The Co-op has brought on an Interim General Manager and will start the GM search for the permanent position soon.
- The Co-op staff from the two stores have voted to unionize. The negotiation process has begun.

Annual Meeting Debrief

- The committee reviewed the Annual Meeting feedback from members. They reflected on the information and shared their thoughts on the event:
 - Good attendance for the size of our co-op
 - Lots of members noted they wanted to attend the meeting to connect with friends and other members. A good opportunity to hang out with the community.
 - The Outreach team felt engaged with the process and the event
 - Nice to be back at the Ferry Terminal Building
 - Meeting space may be too small if we have a larger attendance
 - o Felt more like a celebration than last year
 - Missed the vendors. It was an opportunity to highlight local producers and makers.
 - Happy medium to keep it a mid-range event. The meeting can stay with hearty appetizers, live music and entertainment, and a speaker.

- Liked the purpose of it was informational. A party can be fun but maybe save it for more of a summer event when the purpose is different.
- The annual meeting can't fill all the needs of everyone.

Strategic Plan Update and Draft Review

 - Marketing around educating people about the member benefits
 - Make it a reoccurring community conversation
 - A possible option to have an email list for just the membership base
